Full Member: Year 1 Post Grad - \$75.00 (USD)

The following applies to all "Full Members"

- The minimum standard for election to Member status shall be the receipt of a doctoral degree (or grandfathered masters) from a program primarily psychological in content.
- Members shall be entitled to the rights and privileges of membership as described within the bylaws.
- The requirement of a doctoral degree may be waived by the Board of Directors upon submission of evidence satisfactory to the Board of significant contribution or performance in the field of psychology.

Full Member: Year 2 Post Grad - \$130.00 (USD)

Full Member: Years 3-5 Post Grad - \$180.00 (USD)

Full Member: Years 6-10 Post Grad - \$205.00 (USD)

Full Member: Year 10 + Post Grad - \$230.00 (USD)

Full Member: KS Dual (Full KPA members only.) - \$40.00 (USD)

Be aware that this process of having membership with both MOPA and KPA has changed. In prior years you could purchase your membership for both organizations through MOPA or KPA. That is no longer the case. You now need to purchase your membership from each organization independently. What has remained the same is that you continue to receive a discounted rate on the 2nd membership. If you live in MO you would purchase a MOPA membership on our site and then to go to <http://www.kspsych.org/> to purchase your KPA membership. If you live in KS you would purchase a KPA membership on their site and then come here to purchase the (\$40) membership with MOPA. Also, by selecting this option, you will grant MOPA permission to release your name to KPA for the purpose of verifying your membership with them and to address any customer service issues that may arise.

Other MOPA Membership Types

Professional Affiliate Member (100% Retired Psy) - \$105.00 (USD)

Persons who are previous members who move out of state to areas other than those contiguous with one of the borders of this state, or previous members who no longer wish active participation in the Association due to disability or retirement and non-psychology professionals are eligible for Professional Affiliate membership.

Professional Affiliate Member (Out of State Psy) - \$105.00 (USD)

Persons who are previous members who move out of state to areas other than those contiguous with one of the borders of this state, or previous members who no longer wish active participation in the Association due to disability or retirement and non-psychology professionals are eligible for Professional Affiliate membership.

Student Affiliate Member - \$30.00 (USD)

Undergraduate or graduate students of psychology or psychology-related fields are eligible for Student Affiliate membership and shall automatically become student members of MOPA.

Organizational/Institutional Member - \$500.00 (USD)

Persons or entities who are engaged in work concerns which relate to or impact on the profession of psychology or which relate to associations representing psychologists are eligible for Institutional Membership. Institutional Members shall be entitled to the rights and privileges of membership as set forth in Article VII.

Professional Affiliate Member (Non-Psychology Professional) - \$105.00 (USD)

Persons who are previous members who move out of state to areas other than those contiguous with one of the borders of this state, or previous members who no longer wish active participation in the Association due to disability or retirement and non-psychology professionals are eligible for Professional Affiliate membership.
